(C) Presubscription Charge Application (Cont'd)

- (1) New end users or agents, who will be served by end offices equipped with equal access, will be asked to select a primary IC for both interLATA and intraLATA calls or select one IC for their interLATA calls and a different IC or the Telephone Company for their intraLATA calls at the time they place an order with the Telephone Company for Telephone Exchange Service. A confirming notice will be mailed to the new end user or agent when an IC is verbally chosen.

New end users or agents will be offered a list of participating carriers to aid in their selection of a primary interLATA and intraLATA IC. There will be no charge for this initial selection.

After the end user's or agent's initial primary IC selection, for any change thereafter, a charge, as set forth in (E) following, applies.
