(d) **Connection Charge**

Each user at the time he/she is connected with the waterworks system shall pay a charge to cover the costs of: excavating and tapping the main; furnishing and installing service pipe from the main to the lot line; furnishing and installing corporation and stop cocks; and furnishing and installing meter cock (if outside), yoke, and meter. The charge for a 5/8 inch meter tap shall be \$600.00. In addition to the \$600.00 charge, the customer will be responsible for the actual cost of any road bore required for connection.

(1) 5/8-inch meter \$ 600.00 plus actual cost of road bore.

(2) Larger than 5/8-inch meter
The charge for taps requiring a meter larger than 5/8-inch shall be the actual cost of connection but not less than \$600.00. The customer will be responsible for any road bore required for connection.

(e) **Membership Fees** \$ 100.00

A membership fee of \$100.00 shall be paid in addition to the above connection charges, upon application for membership in this Corporation.

(f) **Delinquencies**

A water service bill which has remained unpaid for a period of more than 17 days following the mailing of the bill shall have a late payment charge added to it, which charge shall be the amount of 10 percent of the first \$3.00 and 3 percent of the excess of \$3.00.

(g) **Reconnection Charge** \$ 25.00

Each user at the time he/she is connected with the waterworks system shall pay a charge to cover the costs of: excavating and tapping the main; furnishing and installing service pipe from the main to the lot line; furnishing and installing corporation and stop cocks; and furnishing and installing meter crock (if outside), yoke, and meter. The charge for a 5/8 inch meter tap shall be \$600.00. In addition to the \$600.00 charge, the customer will be responsible for the actual cost of any road bore required for connection.
