





Subject: WATER RATE INCREASE

A water rate increase in two phases was passed at the Connersville City Council meeting on July 19, 2010. The old rate for Pleasantview was \$4.14 per 1000 gallons. The new rate is \$4.39 per 1000 gallons. This is a 6 % increase now, with the possibility of an additional 6 % increase being implemented in February 2011.

SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES

For use of and service rendered by the water utility based on the use of water supplied by Pleasant View Utilities.

<u>(a) Metered Rates per Month</u>	<u>Rates per 1,000 Gallons</u>
First 1,000 gallons	\$3.60*
Next 1,000 gallons	\$3.60*
Over 2,000 gallons	\$3.60*

(b) Minimum Rate per Month

Each user shall pay a minimum charge in accordance with the following applicable size of meter installed, for which the user will be entitled to the quantity of water set out below.

<u>Size of Meter</u>	<u>Minimum Quantity</u>	<u>Rate</u>
5/8 inch	1,000 gallons	\$3.60*

(c) Reconnection Charge

When the service is turned off for non-payment of bill, or when ever for any reason beyond the control of the Company a re-establishment of service is required by any one customer, a minimum charge of five dollars will be made by the Company to cover a part of the cost of discontinuance and re-establishment of service. This charge together with any arrears due the Company, shall be paid by the customer before service will be re-established.

(d) Late Payment Charge

All bills for water service not paid within seventeen (17) days after the bill is mailed shall be subject to a late payment charge of ten (10) percent of the first three (3) dollars and three (3) percent of the excess of three (3) dollars.

<u>(e) Residential Customer Deposit for Service</u>	\$40.00
