### Process through the IURC 30-Day Filing Procedure

#### RE: Filing for a change in nonrecurring charges – Schedule of Miscellaneous Charges

Dear Mr. Borum:

Pursuant with the Commission's 30-Day filing procedures set forth in 170 Indiana Administrative Code 1-6 for nonrecurring charges, Jackson County REMC is seeking approval to the following changes made to its Schedule of Miscellaneous Charges.


In keeping with the FTC Identity Theft Red Flag Rule requirements that became effective January 1, 2011, we will not continue service for a new customer who has not presented positive identification either in the office or via a notarized statement. We have always charged for a collection trip if necessary due to non-payment of required fees. The proposed Collection Trip wording provides for a trip charge if required either for a new customer's failure to pay required fees or to present positive identification.

The approved Schedule of Miscellaneous Charges filed April 26, 2010 included a \$70.00 reconnection charge in the Reconnection of Service section that would apply to a security light reconnection requiring a separate trip to a service location. Jackson County REMC is proposing to remove the aforementioned wording from the Reconnection of Service section to be incorporated into a separate Security Light Activation section. The Security Light Activation section would also include a proposal for the application of a standard \$70.00 charge for the basic installation of a security light. Any activation associated with maintenance or repair activities, and without billing interruption, would not be subject to this charge.



Exhibit "A" provides the actual construction labor costs associated with the installation for each type of security light offered to the consumers of Jackson County REMC. Even though the installation of a security light is more time consuming than a reconnection of a security light, for the sake of simplicity, Jackson County REMC is proposing a standard \$70.00 fee for approval. As submitted, these changes will become effective on September 1, 2011.

**Schedule of Miscellaneous Charges**

**Collection Trip** - If it shall become necessary to visit a ~~member's premises~~ service location to collect or attempt to collect a delinquent amount due because of a consumer's failure to submit timely payments or to establish account responsibility with positive identification in a timely manner, the ~~member~~ consumer shall be charged \$40.00 for each such visit.

**Bad Check** - Whenever a consumer's payment for any indebtedness to Rural Electric is made by check and said check is returned by the bank for lack of sufficient funds or failure to have an active account, a \$30.00 handling and collection charge will be charged to the consumer's account.

**Reconnection of Service** - Where a service has been disconnected, payment of a standard service charge will be a condition for restoration of service. If the reconnection can be scheduled for normal working hours, the charge shall be \$70.00. If the reconnection requires overtime labor outside of normal working hours, the charge shall be \$150.00.

~~This charge is applicable to reconnection of a metered service and/or a security light service requiring a separate trip to the service location.~~ Reconnection associated with maintenance or repair activities and without billing interruption will not be subject to this charge.

If service has been idle for over five years and the facilities and/or right-of-way are no longer suitable for use, Rural Electric may require the customer to be additionally responsible for the restoration costs according to terms applicable to new service line extensions.

Security Light Activation - Basic installation or reconnection of security light service requiring a separate trip to the service location will be charged a fee of \$70.00. Activation associated with maintenance or repair activities and without billing interruption will not be subject to this charge.

**Temporary Service** - When a consumer has contracted for a permanent service extension and requests a temporary connection from that extension for construction purposes only, Rural Electric will provide a temporary service panel at a rate of \$35.00 for each six-month period or fraction thereof for a maximum period of twenty-four months, by which time the service must be permanently connected or else be subject to disconnection with proper notice until a permanent connection is provided.


