Dear Mr. Borum:

Harrison REMC requests use of the IURC's 30-day filing procedure to update Appendix A- Wholesale Power Cost Tracker applicable to our consumption based retail tariffs.

The enclosed exhibit C indicates that Hoosier Energy overcharged for their wholesale power cost tracker from Jan-June 2011. Hoosier Energy has credited Harrison REMC \$415,346 for this error. Enclosed are calculations showing that passing this credit through to our members would result in a \$-0.003660 per kWh decrease in Harrison REMC's tracker charge.

Harrison REMC proposes to begin billing this credit to our tracker beginning with September 1, 2011 member bills through November 2011 member bills. This method would allow the credit to bill concurrently with our currently approved tracker for September and October member bills resulting in a net power cost tracker charge to our members' of \$0.012792 (\$0.016452- \$0.003660). This tracker credit would also be applied to our yet to be filed 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2011 tracker for November billings only thus reducing the tracker that month by the \$0.003660 credit.

APPENDIX A  
RATE ADJUSTMENTS

RATE ADJUSTMENT

The Rate Adjustment in rates R, TOU, LCP, SC, SC-3P, UBS, IPS, and IPSII shall be on the basis of a Purchased Power Cost Adjustment Tracking Factor occasioned solely by changes in the cost of purchased power.

FUEL COST ADJUSTMENT

The fuel cost adjustment in dollars per kWh shall be the same as that most recently billed to Harrison REMC by its purchased power supplier, divided by one (1.0) minus the total energy losses of the utility for the preceding calendar year expressed as a decimal fraction of the total energy purchased for the same year.

RE: Power Cost Tracker Corrections


The ACES Portfolio Model is an integral part of Hoosier Energy's forecasting process and is used to prepare five-year business plans and the quarterly Power Cost Tracker. ACES has been implementing a new portfolio modeling tool that was used to prepare Hoosier Energy's 2011-2015 business plan and Power Cost Tracker rates beginning January 1, 2011.

Through ongoing analysis of current year results, including comparison of forecasted and actual costs, we determined that forecasted coal costs were being overstated and the model needed adjustment. An adjustment has been made in the mid-year update of the five-year plan and will be used to prepare the Power Cost Tracker rate effective October 1, 2011.

As a result of this adjustment, we have reduced previously published Tracker rates for June and for the July 1- September 30, 2011 period as summarized in Exhibit A. Additionally, we reviewed Tracker rates for January 1 through May 31, 2011 and determined that higher coal forecasts resulted in Hoosier Energy collecting approximately \$4.5 million more than would have been collected absent the overstatement of coal costs. The over collection will be returned to members through a credit on the June billing.

The enclosed information will also be reviewed at the Board meeting.

Notice is hereby given that on July 27, 2011; Harrison Rural Electric Membership Corporation will file before the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (IURC) a request for approval of the application of the Wholesale Power Cost Tracking procedures established by the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission in Cause No. 34614.

This request is being made by reason of a change in Hoosier Energy, Inc.'s wholesale rates to its member Rural Electric Membership Corporations (REMC). This change in rates will be passed through to its member systems' retail rates via the wholesale power cost tracking procedure.

This action will result in a decrease in the wholesale power cost tracker included in the rates charged by Harrison REMC and will affect the consumers of Harrison REMC receiving service pursuant to the schedule of tariffs set forth in Appendix A on file at the IURC. The decrease is expected to be \$0.003660 per kWh (\$3.66 per 1,000 kWh).

This filing is expected to be approved by the IURC by August 26, 2011. If approved, the change would take effect for bills to be rendered beginning with the September 2011 thru November 2011 billing cycles.

**CRAWFORD COUNTY HAS BEEN AWARDED FOOD AND SHELTER EMERGENCY FUND AND SHELTER NATIONAL BOARD PROGRAM.**  
Crawford County has been chosen to receive \$5,777,000 to supplement emergency food and shelter programs in the county.  
The selection was made by a National Board that is chaired by the Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency and consists of representatives from American Red Cross, Catholic Charities USA, The Salvation Army, The Jewish Federation of North America, and United Way Worldwide. The Local Board is charged to distribute funds appropriated by Congress to help expand the capacity of food and shelter programs in high-need areas around the country.

A Board made up of local representatives will determine how the funds awarded to Crawford County are to be dispersed among the emergency food and shelter programs run by local service agencies in the area. The Local Board is responsible for recommending agencies to receive these funds and any additional funds available under this program of the program.  
Under the terms of the grant from the National Board, local agencies chosen to receive funds must: 1) be private voluntary non-profits or units of government, 2) be eligible to receive federal funds, 3) have an accounting system, 4) provide nondiscrimination, 5) have demonstrated the capacity to deliver emergency food and shelter programs, and 6) if they are a private voluntary organization, they must have a voluntary board. Qualifying agencies are urged to apply.
