VECTREN TO REDUCE ELECTRIC RATES THIS QUARTER

Today, in Cause No. 38708 FAC 58, the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission approved a request by the Southern Indiana Gas and electric Company d/b/a Vectren to reduce its fuel cost charge for May, June and July 2003.

The average customer, who uses 1,000 kWh per month, should see **savings** of about **\$1.46** on his or her bill.

Vectren uses Indiana coal as its primary source for electric generation. The Commission is satisfied that the company made every reasonable effort to acquire fuel at the lowest reasonable cost.

Vectren serves nearly 133-thousand electric customers in southern Indiana.
