You are hereby notified that on this date the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") has caused the following entry to be made:

On December 27, 2001, the Commission opened this Cause on its own motion, and, in part, in response to a request for an investigation from the parties, the Indiana Exchange Carrier Association, Inc. ("INECA") and AT&T Communications of Indiana GP and TCG Indianapolis ("AT&T") in Cause No. 42135. In our Order, the Commission stated, as follows:

The Commission welcomes the involvement of all interested parties in this investigation. As noted above, both INECA and AT&T have already indicated the willingness to participate in this investigation. The Commission also will notify all the other parties from Cause No. 40785 of this investigation.

Since that time, the Commission has received Petitions to Intervene from three parties, Time Warner Telecom of Indiana, L.P. ("Time Warner Telecom"), Sprint Communications Company L.P. and United Telephone Company of Indiana, Inc., d/b/a("Sprint"), and Nuvox Communications of Indiana, Inc. ("Nuvox"). The presiding officers will consider the Petitions to Intervene filed in this Cause as Appearances in this Cause.

Furthermore, the presiding officers find that interested parties need not file a Petition to Intervene. Any interested party may participate in this Cause by filing an Appearance either in writing or at the prehearing conference scheduled in this Cause on Tuesday, January 29, 2002, at 1:30 p.m. EST, in Room E-306 of the Indiana Government Center South, 302 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana.
