You are hereby notified that on this date the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") caused the following entry to be made:

On June 25, 2008, the Indiana Universal Service Fund Oversight Committee ("Oversight Committee") filed a Request for Surcharge Exemption ("Motion") in this Cause in which it requested approval of an exemption of the application of the IUSF surcharge to Indiana Lifeline Assistance Program ("ILAP").

The Presiding Officers have reviewed the Motion and find that while the genesis of the Motion appears to bear some relationship to the Commission's Order issued in this Cause on March 17, 2004, the relief requested differs from Cause No. 42144--which is not currently pending before the Commission. Therefore, the Presiding Officers find that the Motion filed in this matter should be recaptioned generally as: "IN THE MATTER OF ISSUES RELATING TO UNIVERSAL SERVICE AND LIFELINE ASSISTANCE FUND ADMINISTRATION ARTICULATED IN CAUSE NOS. 40785 AND 42144 AND PROVISIONS SET FORTH IN HEA 1279, CODIFIED AS IC § 8-1-36" and refiled under 42144 S-3. Presentation of the request in a subdocket will allow for full consideration of the request presented by the Oversight Committee and provide a means for subsequent consideration of fund administration issues generally.
