You are hereby notified that on this date the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") has caused the following entry to be made:

On August 13, 2008, the Indiana Universal Service Fund ("IUSF") Oversight Committee filed a report ("Report") with the Commission regarding its recommended selection of an administrator for the Indiana Lifeline Assistance Program ("ILAP"). The Report was filed in this Cause and in Cause No. 43082, and subsequently resubmitted under Cause No. 42144 S-3, a subdocket recently created to allow the Commission to generally address issues relating to IUSF and ILAP fund administration.

The Presiding Officers hereby advise the parties that further consideration of the Report filed in this matter will be undertaken by the Commission in Cause No. 42144 S-3. Additionally the Presiding Officers hereby amend the caption in that subdocket to incorporate Cause No. 43082. The caption in Cause No. 42144 S-3 is hereby amended as follows:
