On September 2, 2009, AT&T Communications of Indiana, GP ("AT&T") filed its complaint requesting the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") to investigate the intrastate access rates charged by Cinergy Metronet, Inc. and Norlight, Inc., ("Respondents") as captioned above.

On September 18, 2009, October 22, 2009, November 19, 2009, January 19, 2010 and February 18, 2010, Respondents requested and were granted additional time to answer AT&T's Complaint, stating that the parties were engaged in settlement negotiations. The last docket entry issued by the Presiding Officers on February 24, 2010 advised the parties that there would be no future extensions of time granted in this Cause.

On March 19, 2010, AT&T and Respondents filed a joint *Notice of Voluntary Dismissal*, stating that they had resolved all issues related to this Cause. In addition, they stated that they had conferred with the Indiana Office of Utility Consumer Counselor ("OUCC"), and that the OUCC had no objection to the dismissal of this Cause with prejudice.

The Commission finds that this matter is hereby dismissed with prejudice.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE INDIANA UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION that:
