On June 29, 2010, US Signal Company, L.L.C. d/b/a RVP Fiber Co. ("US Signal") filed its Verified Complaint against Indiana Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Indiana ("AT&T"). US Signal and AT&T have negotiated an interconnection agreement amendment, filed with the Commission on December 12, 2010, and issued Non-Docketed Tracking Number 40572-INL-143ND, which resolves the outstanding issues within the Verified Complaint. On January 6, 2011, US Signal filed its *Motion to Dismiss* ("Motion"). The Motion requests that the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") dismiss this Verified Complaint without prejudice because the Verified Complaint has been resolved to the satisfaction of both US Signal and AT&T. Having reviewed the Motion, the Commission now finds that this Cause should be dismissed without prejudice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE INDIANA UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION that:

- 1. This proceeding is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
- 2. This Order shall be effective on and after the date of its approval.
