You are hereby notified that on this date the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") has caused the following entry to be made:

On October 4, 2012, the Indiana Office of Utility Consumer Counselor ("OUCC"), the Indiana Michigan Industrial Group ("I&M-IG") and the Citizens Action Coalition ("CAC") filed a *Joint Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule and to Continue the Evidentiary Hearing* ("Motion") and on October 12, 2012, Indiana Michigan Power Company ("I&M") filed *Petitioner's Agreement to Amend the Procedural Schedule and Continue the Evidentiary Hearing* ("Agreement") in the above referenced Cause.

The Presiding Officers, having reviewed the Motion and the Agreement and being duly advised in the premises, hereby revise the procedural schedule in this Cause as follows:

1. **OUCC's and Intervenors' Supplemental Testimony Prefiling Date.** The OUCC and all Intervenors shall prefile with the Commission any supplemental testimony on or before December 6, 2012. Any such supplemental testimony shall be limited to addressing issues associated with risk reserve, management reserve and contingency issues, including any consequential impacts of such issues on project cost estimates and cost approval recommendations. Copies of same shall be served electronically upon all parties of record.

2. **Petitioner's Supplemental Rebuttal Testimony.** I&M shall prefile any supplemental rebuttal testimony on or before December 20, 2012. Any such supplemental rebuttal testimony shall be limited to responding to the OUCC's and Intervenors' Supplemental Testimony. Copies of same shall be served electronically upon all parties.

3. **Evidentiary Hearing.** The Evidentiary Hearing currently scheduled in this Cause for October 16, 17 and 18, 2012 is hereby continued to January 16, 17 and 22, 2013, commencing at 9:30 a.m. in Room 222 of the PNC Center, 101 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana.

4. **Discovery.** Discovery is available for all parties and shall be conducted on an informal basis. Any response or objection to a discovery request shall be made within ten (10) calendar days of the receipt of such request. On and after December 20, 2012, any response or objection to a discovery request shall be made within five (5) calendar days. The discovery objection and response period shall be tolled from December 20, 2012 through January 2, 2013.
