On December 2, 2013, Land Construction Corporation and Land, Inc. (together, "Respondents") initiated their respective appeals in these Causes. On March 18, 2014, Respondents filed their Verified Motion to Dismiss Pursuant to Agreement, indicating that the Indiana Underground Plant Protection Advisory Committee would reconsider its penalty assessed for alleged pipeline safety violations. On May 22, 2014, the Pipeline Safety Division of the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") filed its Notice of Proof of Amended Recommendations, which stated that the revised penalties for the underlying violations consisted of additional training. Accordingly, the Commission hereby dismisses these Causes with prejudice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE INDIANA UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION that:

1. Cause Nos. 44433 and 44434, initiated on December 2, 2013, are hereby dismissed, with prejudice.
2. This Order shall be effective on and after the date of its approval.
