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**ORDER OF THE COMMISSION**

On April 17, 2014 Bloomingdale Home Telephone Company (“Bloomingdale”) filed its Complaint against Sage Telecom Communications, LLC (“Sage”) with the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (“Commission”). The Parties’ dispute arose over a billing issue between Bloomingdale and Sage. The Commission scheduled a prehearing conference in this matter for May 27, 2014. Thereafter, Sage filed a motion to continue this Cause indicating that it anticipated Bloomingdale and Sage would resolve their disputes. On June 27, 2014, Bloomingdale filed its *Motion to Dismiss Complaint* (“Motion”). The Motion indicated the Parties have settled their issue(s) and no longer require Commission oversight in this matter.

Upon reviewing Bloomingdale’s Motion, the Commission now finds that this Cause should be dismissed with prejudice.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE INDIANA UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION, that:**

1. Cause No. 44484, initiated by the Complaint filed on April 17, 2014 by Bloomingdale Home Telephone Company is hereby dismissed with prejudice.
2. This Order shall be effective on and after the date of its approval.
