ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

On July 30, 2014, the Commission commenced this investigation into the compliance of Snow & Ogden Gas Company, Inc. ("Snow & Ogden") with Pipeline Safety Standards. A Docket Entry was issued on October 29, 2014, holding this matter in abeyance pending the outcome of Cause No. 44563.

On December 30, 2014, the Commission issued its Order in Cause No. 44563 authorizing Snow & Ogden to transfer its certificate of public convenience and necessity to Indiana Gas Company, Inc. d/b/a Vectren Energy Delivery of Indiana, Inc. ("Vectren North"). The Commission further found that upon connection of Snow & Ogden's customers to Vectren North's facilities, Snow & Ogden would no longer have authority to provide natural gas service to the public. On February 11, 2015, Vectren North notified the Commission that on February 4, 2014, it had interconnected its facilities with all of Snow & Ogden's customers that had elected to continue natural gas service.

Accordingly, Snow & Ogden is no longer a public utility with authority to provide natural gas service to the public and this investigation is closed.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE INDIANA UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION that:**

1. The Commission's investigation of Snow & Ogden is closed.
2. This Order shall be effective on and after the date of its approval.
