RE: Washington Township Water Authority Simultaneous Wholesale Water Cost Tracking Factor – 30-Day Filing No. 50004

This filing is being made on behalf of the Washington Township Water Authority ("Washington Township"). On March 29, 2017, the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("TURC") approved 30 day filing No. 50004, the request for a simultaneous change in Washington Township's wholesale water cost tracking factor. The filing was made with the IURC simultaneously with the Bloomington Municipal Water ("Bloomington") rate case (Cause No. 44855). The Authority purchases its water from Bloomington, and it had filed the tracker in order to increase tariff rates to cover the additional costs it would experience once Bloomington's increased rates are in place. Bloomington elected to withhold its tariff filing until its financing is complete. As a result, the Authority's tariff is no longer synchronized with that of its supplier. The Authority is requesting that the effective date of its tariff be amended to match the effective date of Bloomington's final tariff when approved. This will ensure the Authority does not charge its customers for expenses it is not incurring. Washington Township has not implemented the tariff that was approved on March 29, 2017 and does not intend to implement its increase until it receives the amended tariff from the IURC with an effective date matching Bloomington's approved tariff.
