Re: Thirty – Day Filing for Citizens Thermal Pursuant to 170 IAC 1-6

Dear Ms. Becerra:

Pursuant to 170 IAC 1-6-3(3), the Department of Public Utilities for the City of Indianapolis, acting by and through the Board of Directors for Utilities, as trustee, in furtherance of a public trust for the gas and water systems d/b/a Citizens Thermal ("Citizens") respectfully submit for the approval of the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") certain proposed changes to the respective terms and conditions for service (collectively "Terms and Conditions for Service") for the steam utility.

Citizens Thermal restructured its Terms and Conditions in its most recent rate case. This initiative requires certain additions and modifications to Citizens Thermal Terms and Conditions for Service.

The changes to the rules references will help the end-use customer better understand and navigate the Terms and Conditions of the Utility.
