**The Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (IURC) is seeking to fill an attorney** position in its Office of General Counsel. The person filling this position will provide legal advice and expertise to the Commission in a number of areas including utility compliance with existing laws and regulations, matters of public policy, and acceptable standards of operation. This position reports directly to the General Counselor.

Primary responsibilities will include but are not limited to:

- Serves as an advisor to the Commission regarding legal issues and issues of public policy
- Conducting legal research on issues faced by the Commission
- Drafting contracts
- Ensuring compliance with public records requests
- Assisting with legislative inquiries
- Acting as legal liaison to consumer affairs division

Qualifications

- A Juris Doctorate degree and admission, in good standing, to the Indiana Bar are required
- Minimum of two (2) years work experience as a practicing attorney required
- Limited litigation experience is required
- Candidates should have knowledge of utility law or a related field, administrative law, statutory interpretation, Indiana Rules of Trial Procedure, and Indiana Rules of Evidence
- Knowledge of utility and regulatory practices and procedures is desired by not required
- Applicants must demonstrate superior capabilities to communicate orally and in writing
- Excellent organizational skills are required in order to balance the demands of a sizable caseload and other assignments
- Applicants must be able to work productively with limited supervision and in a collaborative setting
- Applicants must be able to analyze technical information found in staff reports, filings, testimony, data, exhibits and tariffs in order to understand and identify issues, make and communicate a complete legal analysis
