

## **ANDREW CAMPBELL**

Andrew Campbell serves as Director of State Policy for Tendril where he is responsible for the company's state level regulatory engagement and strategy. Prior to joining Tendril, Mr. Campbell spent five years at the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) where he served as Chief Energy Advisor to Commissioner Nancy Ryan and Senior Energy Advisor to Commissioner Rachelle Chong. At the CPUC Mr. Campbell was intimately involved in development of the state's smart grid and demand response policies.

Before joining the CPUC in 2005, Mr. Campbell was an investment banker in Salomon Smith Barney's Global Energy group in New York. Prior to that, he worked for ExxonMobil in Houston as a reservoir engineer responsible for enhancing production from oil and gas fields. Mr. Campbell has also served as a graduate intern on the U.S. Senate's Energy and Natural Resources Committee.
