Opportunity for Public Comment on Aqua Indiana Rate Case

What: A field hearing will be held in Ft. Wayne by the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (IURC) to hear from the public on Aqua Indiana's rate case petition, under Cause No. 44752.

When: May 17, 2016, at 6 p.m. EST. Prior to the hearing, the Office of Utility Consumer Counselor (OUCC) will hold an educational session at 5:30 p.m. EST.

Where: Summit Middle School, 4509 Homestead Rd., Ft. Wayne, IN 46814

Why: Aqua Indiana has filed a petition before the IURC for a new schedule of rates and charges for wastewater service.

How: During field hearings, ratepayers have the opportunity to speak directly to the IURC or submit written comments. Please note, though, that because this is a pending case, the commissioners and judge are not allowed to answer questions or engage in any discussion about the case.
