Mr. Pilalis is a Telecommunications Analyst with the Office of Commissioner James H. Cawley, Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Pa. PUC"). Since January 2005, Mr. Pilalis was a Rate Case Review Specialist with the Office of Special Assistants ("OSA") at the Pa. PUC. In 1998-2004, Mr. Pilalis worked with Rhoads and Sinon LLP and Rhoads and Sinon Group LLC.

Mr. Pilalis has had extensive involvement in a number of areas relating to the regulation of telecommunications carriers and services within Pennsylvania, including matters of competition and interconnection under the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996.
