You are hereby notified that on this date the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") caused the following entry to be made:

1. **Data True-up and Quarterly Reporting Issue.** On October 15, 2009, the Indiana Universal Service Fund ("IUSF") Oversight Committee ("Oversight Committee") filed a *Recommendation to (1) Impose a Data True-Up Limitation for the IUSF and (2) To Change from Monthly to Quarterly Reporting* ("Motion"). On October 23, 2009, the Oversight Committee filed an *Addendum* to its Motion. In its Motion and Addendum the Oversight Committee requested that the Commission approve a rolling 24-month period for true-ups to the IUSF. In addition, the Oversight Committee also requested that the Commission modify the frequency for which status reports must be submitted from a monthly to quarterly.

The Presiding Officers, having reviewed the Motion and Addendum, hereby approve a rolling 24-month period for true-ups to the IUSF and modify the frequency in which status reports must be submitted by Solix from a monthly to a quarterly basis. Quarterly filings shall begin in January 2010.

2. **IUSF Surcharge Level Issue.** On November 23, 2009, the IUSF Oversight Committee filed its *Recommendations on IUSF Surcharge* ("Recommendation") with the Commission. In its Recommendation, the Oversight Committee indicated that it has worked with Commission Staff and Solix in analyzing IUSF funding in light of the IUSF assessment surplus that currently exists. Based on this analysis, the Oversight Committee recommended that the IUSF surcharge be reduced from its current level of .538% to .40%. The Oversight Committee indicated that it believes that reducing the IUSF surcharge to .40% will be sufficient to ensure adequate funding reserves while accounting for any future risks that may occur. The Oversight Committee also indicated that approval of a revision to the IUSF surcharge should not be effective for sixty (60) days to provide adequate time to effectuate the change in the IUSF surcharge in billing systems.

The Presiding Officers, having reviewed the Recommendation, hereby find that the IUSF surcharge shall be reduced from its current level of .538% to .40%. Approval of this revision to the IUSF surcharge shall be effective on March 1, 2010.

3. **Reappointment of Oversight Committee Members.** On November 20, 2009, the Board of Directors of the Indiana Exchange Carrier Association, Inc. ("INECA") filed a notice in Cause No. 42144 (and considered in this proceeding) in which it moved for the reappointment of Bruce A. Hazelett, INECA's President, to continue his representation of the rural local exchange carriers on the Oversight Committee. On November 23, 2009, United Telephone Company of Indiana, Inc., d/b/a CenturyLink ("CenturyLink") filed *CenturyLink Motion to Reappoint IUSF Oversight Committee Member*. In its motion, CenturyLink moved for the reappointment of Alan I. Matsumoto as the representative of the Interexchange Carriers ("IXC") on the Oversight Committee.


