#### Who am I?

What do I do?

• Plan UPPA spending, research outreach opportunities, write media items, coordinate training sessions, review UPPA requests, maintain UPPA website

#### What can UPP Account funds be spent on?

- Per IC 8-1-26, funds from the UPP Account must be utilized to improve the safety of Indiana's underground gas facilities. Investments must fall into one of the following:
  - Public Awareness
  - Training and education
  - Incentive Programs

## **Underground Plant Protection Account**

- If Indiana's One-Call law is violated, civil fines can be issued.
- Underground Plant Protection Advisory Committee (UPPAC) recommends a penalty and IURC may approve the penalty.

How much is in there now?

- Approximately \$1.2M\*
- Does NOT revert UPPA is a dedicated fund.

\* Does not count spending approved but not invoiced

• Fiscal Year 2016 total – Approximately \$140,000


• Fiscal Year 2017 total – Approximately \$1.1 M



# More Outreach Efforts

- Facilitator assisted stakeholder meeting for excavators, operators, locators, etc.
- Six, 2016 full-day training sessions dubbed "Safety Days" across Indiana – 3 north, 2 south, 1 central
- Seven 2017 and 2018 Safety Day trainings w/ classroom and mock line-strike
- Media outreach on radio and internet during April 2016 and 2017 – Safe Digging Month
- 100,000 excavator handbooks 80k English, 20k Spanish
- Tri-Town Safety Village 1,500 grade school students and 3 adult training sessions
- Minor league baseball 811 Day, Indians sponsorship

#### Indiana Broadcasters Association effort

- Public Education Program (PEP) through the Indiana Broadcasters Association (IBA)
  - Only available to non-profits and government
  - Only 4 slots in Indiana
  - Full year of radio and TV
  - 95% Indiana residents reached per month (18+)

- 59,000 + ads run in 2017


Exposure in all 92 Counties – 95% Reach



# Outcomes: Awareness

- July 2017 Povaddo 811 Survey
  - \_ 64% of residents aware of "call before you dig service" an 11% increase over 2015 and 19% higher than the national average.
  - 53% of residents have seen 811 advertising an 18% increase over 2015 and 17% higher than the national average.
  - \_ 79% of residents claim they would call 811 if planning a project an increase of 8% over 2015.


• Overall Indiana is now #1 nationally in 811 awareness

# **Outcomes: Education and Training**

- Online training at <u>www.safedigIndiana.com</u> has been launched
  - 2 of 4 modules are completed; expect completion of remaining 2 during 2018
  - 370 professionals have completed training
- Traveling "Safety Day" training sessions in 13 cities; 7 locations in 2018 – approximately 1,000 attendees
  - Indianapolis Fort Wayne South Bend Columbia City
  - Evansville Merrillville Valparaiso Plymouth
  - Scottsburg Terre Haute Noblesville Ft. Benjamin Harris
  - Lafayette
- Midwest Damage Prevention Conference scholarships 2016, 2017, 2018
  - 375 people attended on scholarship
