RE: Washington Township Water Authority; Withdraw of Thirty-Day Filing for Non-Recurring Charge for Utility Locates exceeding one per year.

Dear Ms. Becerra:

On August 29, 2017, our firm filed a 30-day filing on behalf of Washington Township Water Authority ("WTWA") under the Commission's 30-day administrative filing procedures and guidelines pursuant to 170 IAC 1-6-1, *et seq.* The purpose of the 30-day filing was to request a new non-recurring charge for utility locates in excess of one locate per site per person or entity.

After the time of that filing, our firm was informed that the filing did not meet the requirements of 107 IAC 1-6-6 for customer notification. We are withdrawing this filing so that another filing meeting those requirements can be made. A copy of this letter will also be provided to the Indiana Office of the Utility Consumer Counselor.
