




RESOLUTION
OF THE
INDIANA UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION
REPEALING GAO 1984-1

WHEREAS, the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission is a public agency of the State of Indiana charged by statute with the regulation and supervision of utility rates and services in Indiana;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission hereby repeals GAO 1984-1, the Commission's policy stating that the public has open and complete access to the administrative hearing process and decisions of the Commission. Since the passage of GAO 1984-1, the Indiana General Assembly enacted new Public Access Laws addressing the same issues as addressed in GAO 1984-1. Therefore, the GAO has become moot.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that this Resolution shall become effective on and after January 30, 2009.
