Request(s): Sprint is proposing several changes to its intrastate access tariff related to Toll Free Calling. Specifically, Sprint: (1) introduces Toll Free 8YY Transit Traffic Service when a third party originates the call and Sprint simply transports the call; (2) makes text changes to the description of Toll Free Database Access Service; (3) clarifies which switched access rate elements are applied to particular toll free services, for billing purposes; and (4) reduces the Toll Free Database Access Service Basic Query rate from \$0.016230 to \$0.00500 per query.
