**NOTICE OF PROPOSED NEW LOCAL RULE
CONCERNING PROBLEM SOLVING COURTS**

In accordance with Trial Rule 81 of the Indiana Court Rules, the Adams Circuit and Superior Courts hereby give notice to the bar and the public that the Courts propose to add a new local rule on **Problem Solving Courts** at **LR01-AR00-02**, to be effective **September 1, 2015**.

In accordance with Trial Rule 81(B), and because good cause exists under TR 81(D) to deviate from the schedule for amending local court rules, the time period for the bar and the public to comment shall begin on **July 22, 2015** and shall close on **August 23, 2015**.

LR01-AR00-02 PROBLEM-SOLVING COURTS

Those persons directed to participate in the Adams County Drug Court shall be assessed in accordance with the following Schedule of Fees pursuant to the authority granted by Indiana Code 33-23-16-23:

- A.** Participants admitted to the Adams County Drug Court shall be assessed an administration fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) upon admission into the program.
- B.** Participants admitted to the Adams County Drug Court shall be assessed a monthly user fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) beginning with the second month of participation and for each month thereafter for the duration of their participation in the program.
- C.** Participants admitted to the Adams County Drug Court shall be responsible for all chemical testing fees. Participants shall be responsible for the cost of any confirmatory test.
- D.** Participants admitted to the Adams County Drug Court but transferred to another Indiana Drug Court are assessed a transfer fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00), payable at the time of transfer.
- E.** Participants admitted to the Adams County Drug Court from another Indiana Drug Court are assessed a transfer fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00). These participants are assessed a monthly user fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) beginning the second month of involvement and for each month thereafter for the duration of their participation in the Adams County Drug Court.
- F.** All fees assessed herein in subsections A-E are due and payable to the Adams County Clerk's Office.
- G.** Participants admitted to the Adams County Drug Court will be assessed a fee for substance abuse services received as a result of referrals made by the Court, and participants may be further assessed fees for mental health services, other health services, and monitoring services received as a result of referrals made by the Court. Fees for these services are payable to the entity providing the service.
