REQUEST FOR APPROVAL TO RE-ADOPT
CURRENT CASELOAD ALLOCATION RULE

The judges of Boone County have met and reviewed the 2014 weighted caseload statistics for the courts of record. Our review indicates that the difference in utilization between any two courts of record does not exceed .40 based on the 2014 Weighted Caseload Report.


Our existing caseload plan is written such that no amendment is necessary considering the change of classifications of felonies from class/letter designation to level/number designation and we have made no changes to the current allocation of criminal cases.

Accordingly, the judges of the courts of record have decided to re-adopt their local rule pertaining to caseload allocation as required by Administrative Rule 1. This local rule was previously published for public comment as required by Trial Rule 81 and approved by the Supreme Court. We request Supreme Court approval to re-adopt the current local rule on caseload allocation.
