
REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF LOCAL RULE
RE-ADOPTING CURRENT CASELOAD
ALLOCATION RULE

The judges of the court of record of Fayette County have met and reviewed the 2014 weighted caseload statistics of the courts of record, which review reveals that the difference in utilization between the two courts of record in 2014 was within the .40 variance which is permissible under Ind. Administrative Rule 1 (E).


Accordingly, the judges of the courts of record have decided to re-adopt their local rule at LR21-TR00-TR-4 and LR 21-CR00-CR-3, pertaining to caseload allocation as required by Administrative Rule 1, which local rule had previously been published for public comment as required by Trial Rule 81 and which has been approved by the Supreme Court, and request the Supreme Court to approve the re-adoption of the local caseload allocation rule.
