

ORDER APPOINTING JUDGE PRO TEMPORE

This Court has been advised of the need for the appointment of a Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Jasper Superior Court because the Hon. J. Philip McGraw, Judge of the Jasper Superior Court, is currently unable to perform the duties of his office due to medical reasons. Accordingly, we find that in the interests of continuing the orderly administration of justice and pursuant to Ind.Trial Rule 63(B), a Judge *Pro Tempore* should be appointed to discharge temporarily the duties of that office. Further, this Court has been advised that the Hon. Robert M. Hall, a Senior Judge, is willing to serve as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Jasper Superior Court.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the Hon. Robert M. Hall, is appointed as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Jasper Superior Court, effective February 17, 2006, until further order of this Court. This order shall be sufficient authority for Judge Hall to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Jasper Superior Court. Judge Hall shall be entitled to compensation for this service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of his appointment, pursuant to T.R. 63(D).

The Clerk of this Court is directed to forward a certified copy of this Order to the Clerk of the Jasper Superior Court, who is directed to enter this Order into the Record of Judgments

and Orders; to the Hon. J. Philip McGraw, Jasper Superior Court, 115 West Washington Street, Rensselaer, IN 47978-2890; to the Hon. Robert M. Hall, 520 North Monroe Street, Williamsport, IN 47993; to the Division of State Court Administration, payroll department; and to the Indiana Judicial Center.
