Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

The Honorable J. Scott Vanderbeck, Judge of the LaGrange Circuit Court, has notified this Court of his resignation from the office effective June 1, 2018. As a result, we find that in the interest of continuing the orderly administration of justice and pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, a Judge *Pro Tempore* should be appointed temporarily to discharge the duties of that office. Senior Judge G. David Laur has indicated his willingness to serve as Judge *Pro Tempore* until such time as a successor assumes the office.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the Honorable G. David Laur is appointed as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the LaGrange Circuit Court effective June 2, 2018, until further order of this Court or such time as a successor assumes office, whichever occurs first.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Judge Laur to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the LaGrange Circuit Court. Judge Laur shall be entitled to compensation for this service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of his appointment, pursuant to T.R. 63(D).
