**Order Granting Stay Pending Appeal**

Appellant, Gregory Zoeller, Attorney General of Indiana, files "Appellant's Unopposed Motion For Stay Pending Appeal."

In July, the Lake Circuit Court granted summary judgment to Appellees (collectively "the Union") after ruling that Indiana's "Right To Work" law, Indiana Code § 22-6-6-8, was unconstitutional. On August 13, 2014, the trial court denied Appellant's motion to stay enforcement of the judgment pending this appeal. After that motion was denied, Appellant filed a motion requesting a stay from this Court according to the terms of Indiana Appellate Rule 39. The motion indicates that the request for a stay is unopposed by the Appellees.

Being duly advised, the motion is GRANTED, and enforcement of the July 17, 2014 judgment of the Lake Circuit Court is hereby STAYED. This stay will be in effect until (1) the conclusion of this appeal or (2) this Court issues an order or opinion otherwise terminating the stay.

The Clerk is directed to send copies of this order to the Hon. George C. Paras, Special Judge, Lake Circuit Court; and to all counsel of record.
