
ORDER

The Relator, by counsel, filed a petition for writ of mandamus and prohibition (“petition”) and accompanying application papers under the rules governing original actions. A party opposing the Relator in the trial court filed a response opposing issuance of the writ. The Relator then tendered a reply in support of his petition. The Court allows the filing of the Relator’s reply and directs the Clerk to show the reply filed as of its date of tender, October 20, 2014.

Each Justice has had an opportunity to review the petition and other papers filed in this original action and to discuss this matter in conference with the other Justices, and each Justice has voted to deny the petition. The Relator fails to show that denial of the petition will result in extreme hardship or that the remedy available by appeal will be wholly inadequate. *See* Ind. Original Action Rule 3(A). Accordingly, the Court DENIES the Relator’s petition.
