ORDER TERMINATING JUDGE PRO TEMPORE
AND RESUMPTION OF DUTIES OF SITTING JUDGE

On August 24, 2014, the Honorable George A. Hopkins, Judge of the Howard Superior Court 4, requested this Court to appoint a Judge Pro Tempore pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63(B)(1). This court issued an Order on September 8, 2014 appointing the Honorable Donald E. Currie to serve as Judge Pro Tempore. Now, on October 27, 2014, Judge Hopkins has filed, pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63(B)(4), a verified request for reinstatement effective November 3, 2014.

And this Court, being duly advised, now finds that Judge Hopkins shall resume the duties of his office as Judge of the Howard Superior Court 4 and that Judge Currie's service as Judge Pro Tempore should be terminated, both effective November 3, 2014.


IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the appointment of the Honorable Donald E. Currie as Judge Pro Tempore of the Howard Superior Court 4 is terminated effective November 3, 2014.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Honorable George A. Hopkins shall resume the duties of his office as Judge of the Howard Superior Court No. 4 effective November 3, 2014.
