ORDER APPOINTING JUDGE PRO TEMPORE


The Honorable Keith A. Meier, Judge of the Warrick Superior Court 1, has notified this Court of his resignation from the office effective September 1, 2015. Further, this Court has been advised that the Governor's appointee will not assume the office effective September 1. As a result, we find that in the interests of continuing the orderly administration of justice and pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, a Judge *Pro Tempore* should be appointed temporarily to discharge the duties of that office. Judge Meier has indicated his willingness to serve as Judge *Pro Tempore* until such time as the Governor's appointee can assume the office.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the Honorable Keith A. Meier is appointed as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Warrick Superior Court 1 effective September 1, 2015, until further order of this Court or such time as the Governor's appointee assumes office, whichever occurs first.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Judge Meier to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Warrick Superior Court 1. Judge Meier shall be entitled to compensation for this service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at

the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of his appointment,
pursuant to T.R. 63(D).
