

Order Appointing Judge *Pro Tempore*

Previously, the Honorable Jane Spencer Craney, Judge of the Morgan Superior Court 3, notified the Court of her temporary inability to perform the duties of her office. By Order dated August 30, 2016, this Court assigned Senior Judges G. Thomas Gray, Kim Van Valer, and Douglas E. Van Winkle to serve in Morgan Superior Court 3. Additionally, the Order temporarily transferred Judges Christopher L. Burnham, Peter R. Foley, and Matthew G. Hanson to Morgan Superior Court 3.

We now find that in the interest of continuing the orderly administration of justice alternative arrangements for a judicial officer in Morgan Superior Court 3 are necessary. The Court has been advised that Senior Judge Jeffrey C. Eggers is willing to serve as Judge *Pro Tempore* in Morgan Superior Court 3 commencing October 31, 2016.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that:

1. Senior Judge Jeffrey C. Eggers is appointed as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Morgan Superior Court 3 effective October 31, 2016, until further order of this Court. This Order shall be sufficient authority for Judge Eggers to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Morgan Superior Court 3. Judge Eggers shall be entitled to compensation for this service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of his appointment, pursuant to T.R. 63(D).

2. The assignment of Senior Judges G. Thomas Gray, Kim Van Valer, and Douglas E. Van Winkle to the Morgan Superior Court 3 is concluded. The Court is grateful for their willingness to serve.

3. The temporary transfer of Judges Christopher L. Burnham, Peter R. Foley, and Matthew G. Hanson to Morgan Superior Court 3 is rescinded. Likewise, their willingness to assist in continuing the operations of Morgan Superior Court 3 is appreciated by the Court.
