ORDER APPOINTING SUCCESSOR JUDGE PRO TEMPORE


The Honorable Gretchen Lund, Judge of the Goshen City Court, notified this Court of her resignation from the office effective August 15, 2014. As a result, the Honorable Walter H. Palmer, a Senior Judge, was appointed as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Goshen City Court effective August 18, 2014 through August 29, 2014. A Governor's appointee having not qualified to assume the office we find that in the interests of continuing the orderly administration of justice and pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, a Judge *Pro Tempore* should be appointed temporarily to discharge the duties of that office. Further, this Court has been advised that Senior Judge Robert Probst is willing to serve as Judge *Pro Tempore*.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the Honorable Robert Probst is appointed as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Goshen City Court effective September 4, 2014 through September 29, 2014, covering court sessions occurring on Mondays and Thursdays or as otherwise arranged by Judge Probst. Judge Probst's appointment shall terminate on the date set forth above or at such time as the Governor's appointee assumes office, whichever occurs first.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Judge Probst to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Goshen City Court. Judge Probst shall be compensated as a senior judge and will submit claims accordingly.

The Clerk of this Court is directed to forward a certified copy of this Order to the Clerk of the Goshen City Court, who is directed to enter this Order into the Record of Judgments and Orders; to the Hon. Walter H. Palmer; to the Hon. Robert Probst; to the Hon. Allan J. Kaufman, Mayor, 202 South Fifth Street, Goshen, Indiana, 46528; to the Division of State Court Administration and to the Indiana Judicial Center. The Clerk is also directed to post this Order on the Court's website
