ORDER APPOINTING JUDGE PRO TEMPORE

The Honorable Carl Taul, Judge of the Ripley Circuit Court, has notified this Court of his resignation from the office effective September 12, 2014. As a result, we find that in the interests of continuing the orderly administration of justice and pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, a Judge *Pro Tempore* should be appointed temporarily to discharge the duties of that office. Further, this Court has been advised that the Honorable Ted Todd, a Senior Judge, is willing to serve as Judge *Pro Tempore*.


IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the Honorable Ted Todd is appointed as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Ripley Circuit Court effective September 15, 2014, until further order of this Court or such time as the Governor's appointee assumes office, whichever occurs first.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Judge Todd to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Ripley Circuit Court. Judge Todd shall be entitled to compensation for this service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of his appointment, pursuant to T.R. 63(D).

The Clerk of this Court is directed to forward a certified copy of this Order to the Clerk of the Ripley Circuit and Superior Courts, who is directed to enter this Order into the Record of

Judgments and Orders; to the Hon. Carl Taul; to the Hon. Ted Todd; to the Division of State Court Administration and to the Indiana Judicial Center.
