Notice of Proposed New Local Rule, Requesting Comments and Finding Good Cause to Deviate From Established Schedule

The judges of the Rush Circuit and Superior Courts, pursuant to Trial Rule 81(B), give notice of a proposed new local rule on **Schedule of Fees for Problem-Solving Court Services at LR70-AR00-4** and find good cause to deviate from the schedule for adopting local rules under Trial Rule 81(D).

Notice has been given to the public by posting on the website of the Rush County Clerk and on the Indiana Judicial Website, and by furnishing a copy to the officers of the Rush County Bar Association. Comments may be made until November 8, 2015. This new rule will be effective on January 1, 2016.

LR70-AR00-4 Schedule of Fees for Problem-Solving Court Services

Those persons directed to participate in the Rush County Addictions Intervention Court (A.I.C.) may be assessed fees in accordance with the following **SCHEDULE OF FEES** pursuant to the authority granted by Ind. Code 33-23-16-23:

- (1) A Drug Court administration fee of \$100.00, per participant, payable to Rush County Community Corrections;
- (2) A Drug Court user fee of \$50.00 per month for every month that an individual participates in Drug Court (commencing the second month of participation), payable to Rush County Community Corrections;
- (3) A Drug Court drug testing fee as follows: \$10.00 per drug screen, payable to Rush County Community Corrections; and
- (4) A Drug Court transfer fee of \$25.00 per participant per transfer; payable to Rush County Community Corrections.
