

**ORDER INCREASING SENIOR JUDGE SERVICE DAYS
FOR THE HARRISON SUPERIOR COURT**

The presiding judge of the Harrison Superior Court has requested an increase in senior judge service days as a result of certain community and judicial commitments.

This Court adopted revisions to Administrative Rule 5 on December 3, 2003, which made certain changes to the senior judge program in recognition of the importance of senior judges to the administration of justice in Indiana trial courts. Accordingly, we find that the Harrison Superior Court has demonstrated the need for additional judicial resources based on the circumstances presented by that court, and would benefit from additional senior judge service days to assist with the caseload of that court. This Court may re-examine this increase at a later date in light of weighted caseload statistics and other circumstances, and make adjustments accordingly.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the allocation of senior judge service days for the Harrison Superior Court be increased to twenty-five (25) days, to be utilized at the

discretion of the presiding judge of the Harrison Superior Court for the calendar year 2005 and the calendar year 2006.

The Clerk of this Court is directed to forward a certified copy of this order to the Honorable Roger D. Davis, presiding judge of the Harrison Superior Court; to the clerk of the Harrison Superior Court, for entry in the Record of Judgments and Orders; to the Indiana Judicial Center; to the Judicial Qualifications Commission; and to the Division of State Court Administration, Payroll Section.
