ORDER AMENDING SERVICE DAY LIMITS FOR SENIOR JUDGES IN THE
JASPER CIRCUIT COURT FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2008

On January 31, 2008, this Court issued an Order establishing service day limits for senior judges in each trial court for calendar year 2008. The Honorable John D. Potter, Judge of the Jasper Circuit Court, has requested an increase in the number of senior judge service days allotted to the court.


And this Court, being duly advised, now finds that Judge Potter has established sufficient reasons for the allotment of additional senior judge service days to the Jasper Circuit Court.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the number of senior judge service days allotted to the Jasper Circuit Court is increased from thirty (30) days to forty-two (42) days for the calendar year beginning **January 1, 2008** and ending **December 31, 2008**. It is the responsibility of the presiding judge of the Jasper Circuit Court to ensure that the number of senior judge service days allotted is not exceeded during the year of appointment.

The Clerk of the Jasper Circuit Court is directed to enter this Order in the Record of Judgments and Orders of the Court.
