

ORDER AMENDING SERVICE DAY LIMITS FOR SENIOR JUDGES IN THE
SULLIVAN SUPERIOR COURT FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2009

On January 23, 2009, the Honorable Robert E. Springer, Judge of the Sullivan Superior Court made a request to increase the number of senior judge service days allotted to the court for 2009.

And this Court, being duly advised, now finds that Judge Springer has established sufficient reasons for the allotment of additional senior judge service days to the Sullivan Superior Court.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the number of senior judge service days allotted to the Sullivan Superior Court is increased by fifteen (15) days above the number of days assigned in our yet to be issued Order establishing senior judge service days for all courts for calendar year 2009. It is the responsibility of the presiding judge of the Sullivan Superior Court to ensure that the number of senior judge service days allotted is not exceeded during the year of appointment.

The Clerk of the Sullivan Superior Court is directed to enter this Order in the Record of Judgments and Orders of the Court.
