ORDER REMANDING JURISDICTION TO TRIAL COURT

Comes now the Hon. William E. Vance, Special Judge in the above matter, and pursuant to Ind.Trial Rule 79, certifies this matter here for the appointment of a special judge.

And this Court, being duly advised, now finds that jurisdiction of this matter should be remanded to the Jackson Superior Court and Judge Bruce Markel III. Upon discontinuation of service of a special judge, the regular judge of the court where the case is pending shall assume jurisdiction, provided such judge has not previously served in the case and is otherwise eligible to serve. Ind. Trial Rule 79(I).

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that jurisdiction of this matter is remanded to the Jackson Superior Court and Judge Markel.
