ORDER REMANDING JURISDICTION TO TRIAL COURT

Comes now the Clerk of the Tippecanoe Superior Court, and pursuant to Ind.Trial Rule 53.1, certifies this matter here for the appointment of a special judge.

And this Court, being duly advised, now finds that jurisdiction of this matter should be remanded to the Tippecanoe Superior Court and Judge Faith Graham. The purpose of Ind. Trial Rule 53.1 is to ensure the timely ruling on matters pending before the court. Here, appointing a special judge would only likely serve to delay this proceeding longer.
