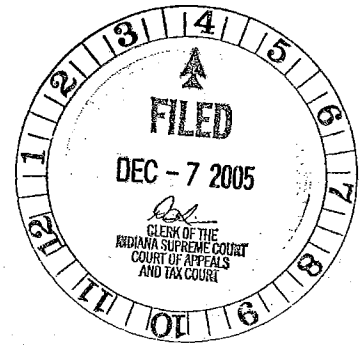

**ORDER AMENDING SENIOR JUDGE SERVICE DAYS
FOR THE GIBSON SUPERIOR COURT**

The presiding judge of the Gibson Superior Court has requested additional senior judge service days as a result of time commitments relating to judicial education.

We find that the judge of the Gibson Superior Court has demonstrated the need for additional judicial resources in addition to those senior judge service days previously authorized. This Court may re-examine this increase at a later date in light of weighted caseload statistics and other circumstances, and make adjustments accordingly.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the allocation of senior judge service days for the Gibson Superior Court be increased to thirty (30) days for the 2006 calendar year, to be utilized at the discretion of the presiding judge of the Gibson Superior Court, to handle court matters during the absence of the regular judge while fulfilling his judicial educational obligations.

The Clerk of this Court is directed to forward a certified copy of this order to the Honorable Earl G. Penrod, presiding judge of the Gibson Superior Court; to the clerk of the Gibson Superior Court, for entry in the Record of Judgments and Orders; to the Indiana Judicial Center; to the Judicial Qualifications Commission; and to the Division of State Court Administration, Payroll Section.
