2010 PLAN SUMMARY

Since the greatest need in District One remains the need to provide legal representation to the second largest poverty population in the state, we continue to concentrate our efforts on finding the generous attorneys who will accept case after case after case. We continue to log between 25 and 30 phone calls daily and have begun to log the actual time spent by our Plan Administrator and her recently hired assistant, Atty Stephanie Wicke, advising and providing information to applicants in lieu of or while waiting for referral. Our budget reflects the cost of the increased salary and expansion of our office space incurred by this badly needed addition to our staff but we have not budgeted for any salary increases and have only budgeted for expect cost of living increases in other expenses, if any. Our IOLTA request is lowered only because we currently project a substantial carry over from 2009 to 2010.

Our Committee continues to meet quarterly. We have Lawyer Recruitment, Law Firm Recruitment, and CLE/Public Information subcommittees. One of our Board members, Kevin McGrath, single handedly organized both the LaPorte and Michigan City Talk to a Lawyer sites for MLK Day, 2009 and recruited 19 attorneys to staff them. In 2009 our Chair attended the Equal Justice Conference along with our Plan Administrator.

Our primary lawyer recognition event continues to be our Volunteer Night at the Railcats minor league baseball stadium, preceded by supper and awards at the Bennigans restaurant attached to the stadium bleacher seats. Attorneys have started bringing their families and start asking for the date as soon as spring training begins.

We expect to continue to work with our public libraries both for the MLK TALT event and in assisting the public with new cooperative family law processes established by Lake County local rule in 2008, effective in 2009, including use of the Up to Parents website.

Our Plan Administrator makes annual presentations at the Bridging the Gap professionalism seminar for new lawyers, is a member of the Advisory Committee for the Lake Superior Court, Room Three, Family Court Pro Se Clinic, chairs the ProBono Committee of the Lake County Bar Association, is a member of the ISBA Pro Bono Committee, sits on the newly formed board of directors for Sojourner Truth House, a day shelter for women and children operating in Gary, and continues on the Northwest Indiana Regional Workforce Board. We have been in discussion with Lake Juvenile Court to establish a pro se clinic for paternity/post-paternity cases. Attorney Wicke has begun to adapt the divorce court forms for use in these juvenile court cases.

We are in the process of developing a website and will be experimenting with a web based application process adapted from those currently in use District 14.

Finally, we continue to promote the "unbundling" of legal services, the establishment of pro se clinics and "modest means" panels and to honor, thank, and bless all the attorneys who volunteer...to anticipate all those who will volunteer for the first time in 2010...and to admire

the courage and decency of the increasing numbers of folks who struggle to meet their and their family's basic human needs and who ask us and our colleagues to help them with the legal problems that all too often add to their burdens.

2008 REPORT

Please provide a short summary of how the provision of pro bono service is coordinated in your district, including the intake process, the relationships of pro bono providers in the district, how referrals are made, and how reporting is done.

Aside from Indiana Legal Services and the Valparaiso University School of Law student clinics, the only other known provider of civil pro bono services in the First District is the City of Hammond Legal Aid Clinic established in late 2004. That clinic limits its services to individuals who have been residents of the city of Hammond for at least nine (9) months and is staffed by two (2) attorneys, a secretary, and legal interns using substantial funds appropriated by the Hammond City Council. The City has executed a policy requiring attorneys who have contracts with the City to do a certain amount of pro bono work. Staff attorneys also provide representation.

We have a cordial and collaborative relationship with all three of the above entities. However, despite our ongoing requests, we do not receive any reports from the City of Hammond Clinic on how much service is actually provided by pro bono attorneys and how much by staff.

Our intake process: We do all the pro bono referrals for clients of the Gary and South Bend ILS offices in the counties in our district. ILS staff forwards intake and eligibility information to us. In 2008 we received 93 referrals from ILS, about 29% of our total intake. We also take applications via phone and email from individuals referred by various social services entities, courts, other attorneys, and the Web. Our staff also provides a substantial amount of legal advice and information to clients while they are on the waiting list for an attorney.

We send regular queries to our volunteers to track the status of the case, the number of hours donated, and any requests for supportive services or reimbursement of out-of-pocket expenses. Upon notification by the attorney that representation is concluded, a satisfaction questionnaire is sent to the client. Favorable responses are forwarded to the volunteer as part of our thank you process.

Please describe any special circumstances affecting your District's 2008 implementation of its plan.

Other than the constant reality of increasing need and never enough volunteers, our major challenge was the need to hire an assistant since we receive approximately 30 calls a day plus assorted emails asking for help. This was finally accomplished and Attorney Stephanie Wicke came on Board half-time in October, 2008.

We also were hampered in attempting to meet with the judiciary in all 7 counties because in most of the counties many of the judges were either up for retention or election in contested races. Coordinating schedules is not an easy task!

Finally, as always, some sort of mandatory reporting as is being implemented in other states, including our neighbor Illinois, would be a blessing both for recruiting and for reporting and acknowledging the attorneys
