ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1168

DIGEST OF HB1168 (Updated February 10, 1998 11:54 am - DI 75)

Citations Affected: IC 9-13.

Synopsis: Motor vehicles. Changes the definition of "new motor vehicle" to mean a motor vehicle that either: (1) has not been previously titled and carries a manufacturer's certificate of origin; or (2) has never been transferred to an ultimate purchaser. (Current law requires both conditions to be satisfied.)

Effective: July 1, 1998.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 9-13-2-111 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 111. "New motor
3 vehicle" means a motor vehicle:

- 4 (1) that has not been previously titled under IC 9-17 and carries
5 a manufacturer's certificate of origin; ~~and or~~
6 (2) that has never been transferred by a manufacturer, distributor,
7 or dealer to an ultimate purchaser.
