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# ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1213

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DIGEST OF HB 1213 (Updated February 19, 1998 11:41 am - DI 75)

**Citations Affected:** IC 4-2.

**Synopsis:** State elected officials salaries. Increases the salaries of the governor and the lieutenant governor, beginning when the individuals elected in 2000 assume those offices. Increases the salaries of the secretary of state, the auditor of state, the treasurer of state, and the clerk of the supreme court, beginning when the individuals elected in 1998 assume those offices. Increases the salaries of the superintendent of public instruction and the attorney general, effective January 1, 1999. Provides a \$12,000 annual housing maintenance allowance for all state elected officials except the governor effective January 1, 1999.

**Effective:** January 1, 1998 (retroactive).

## ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1213

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A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state offices and administration.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 4-2-1-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
2 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 1. The salary of the elected officials  
3 of the state is as follows:

4 (1) For **the** governor **the following salary:**

5 (A) **Before January 8, 2001**, seventy-seven thousand two  
6 hundred dollars (\$77,200) per year.

7 (B) **After January 7, 2001, ninety-five thousand dollars**  
8 **(\$95,000) per year.**

9 (2) For **the** lieutenant governor **the following salary:**

10 (A) **Before January 8, 2001**, sixty-four thousand dollars  
11 (\$64,000) per year.

12 (B) **After January 7, 2001, seventy-six thousand dollars**  
13 **(\$76,000) per year.**

14 However, the lieutenant governor is not entitled to receive per  
15 diem allowance for performance of ~~his~~ duties as president of the  
16 senate.

 2 (A) Before January 1, 1999, forty-six thousand dollars  
 3 (\$46,000) per year.  
 4 (B) After December 31, 1998, sixty-six thousand dollars

 6 (4) For the auditor of state the following salary:  
 7 (A) Before December 1, 1998, forty-six thousand dollars  
 8 (\$46,000) per year.  
 9 (B) After November 30, 1998, sixty-six thousand dollars

 11 (5) For the treasurer of state the following salary:  
 12 (A) Before February 10, 1999, forty-six thousand dollars

 16 (6) For the attorney general the following salary:  
 17 (A) Before January 1, 1999, fifty-nine thousand two hundred  
 18 dollars (\$59,200) per year.  
 19 (B) After December 31, 1998, seventy-nine thousand four  
 20 hundred dollars (\$79,400) per year.  
 21 (7) For the clerk of the supreme court the following salary:  
 22 (A) Before January 1, 1999, thirty-eight thousand dollars  
 23 (\$38,000) per year.  
 24 (B) After December 31, 1998, sixty thousand dollars  
 25 (\$60,000) per year.  
 26 (8) For the state superintendent of public instruction the  
 27 following salary:  
 28 (A) Before January 1, 1999, sixty-three thousand one  
 29 hundred dollars (\$63,100) per year.  
 30 (B) After December 31, 1998, seventy-nine thousand four  
 31 hundred dollars (\$79,400) per year.  
 32 SECTION 2. IC 4-2-1-3 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS  
 33 A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
 34 JANUARY 1, 1999]: Sec. 3. (a) This section does not apply to the  
 35 governor.  
 36 (b) Each elected official of the state is entitled to a housing  
 37 maintenance allowance of twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) per  
 38 year in addition to the salary provided under section 1 of this  
 39 chapter.

Mr. President: The Senate Committee on Finance, to which was referred House Bill 1213, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

Replace the effective date in SECTION 1 with "[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]".

Page 1, line 12, delete "eighty" and insert "**seventy-six**".

Page 1, line 12, delete "eight hundred".

Page 1, line 13, delete "\$80,800" and insert "**(\$76,000)**".

Page 2, delete lines 15 through 16, begin a new line block indented and insert:

"(6) For **the attorney general the following salary:**

**(A) Before January 1, 1999**, fifty-nine thousand two hundred dollars (\$59,200) per year.

**(B) After December 31, 1998, seventy-nine thousand four hundred dollars (\$79,400) per year."**

Page 2, delete lines 22 through 24, begin a new line block indented and insert:

"(8) For **the state superintendent of public instruction the following salary:**

**(A) Before January 1, 1999**, sixty-three thousand one hundred dollars (\$63,100) per year.

**(B) After December 31, 1998, seventy-nine thousand four hundred dollars (\$79,400) per year."**

Replace the effective date in SECTION 2 with "[EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1999]".

Page 2, line 28, delete "or the lieutenant governor".

Page 2, delete line 33.

and when so amended that said bill do pass.
