## ENGROSSED SENATE BILL No. 94

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A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 5-21-1-2, AS AMENDED BY P.L.45-1996,  
2 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
3 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 2. "Authorized user" means:  
4 (1) any board, commission, department, agency, or authority, by  
5 whatever name designated, exercising a portion of the executive,  
6 administrative, legislative, or judicial power of the state;  
7 (2) any county, city, town, township, school corporation, political  
8 subdivision, or other entity, by whatever name designated,  
9 exercising in a limited geographical area the executive,  
10 administrative, legislative, or judicial power of the state or a local  
11 governmental power;  
12 (3) any entity that is subject to:  
13 (A) budget review by the state board of tax commissioners or  
14 the governing body of a county, city, town, township, or school  
15 corporation; or  
16 (B) audit by the state board of accounts;

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- 1 (4) any building corporation of a political subdivision of the state
- 2 that issues bonds for the purpose of constructing public facilities;
- 3 (5) any advisory commission, committee, or body created by
- 4 statute, ordinance, or executive order and requiring the use of the
- 5 intelenet system;
- 6 (6) the Indiana higher education telecommunications system
- 7 (IC 20-12-12) and all of the colleges and universities included in
- 8 that system;
- 9 (7) any Indiana broadcasting station licensed by the Federal
- 10 Communications Commission as a noncommercial radio or
- 11 television station for the purposes of educational programming;
- 12 **or**
- 13 (8) any community network; **or**
- 14 **(9) any nonpublic school (as defined in IC 20-10.1-1-3).**
- 15 **SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.**
