DIGEST OF SB0189 (Updated February 16, 1998 5:37 pm - DI 76)

Citations Affected: IC 12-27-9-1.

Synopsis: Enhanced ombudsman authority. Expands the population that may be served by the mental health ombudsman program by repealing a provision that limits the population served by the program to those individuals who have been transferred from or discharged from a state institution. (The introduced version of this bill was prepared by the commission on mental health.).

Effective: Upon passage.

Additions: Whenever a new statutory provision is being enacted (or a new constitutional provision adopted), the text of the new provision will appear in **this style type**. Also, the word **NEW** will appear in that style type in the introductory clause of each SECTION that adds a new provision to the Indiana Code or the Indiana Constitution.

Conflict reconciliation: Text in *this style type* or ~~this style type~~ reconciles conflicts between statutes enacted by the 1997 General Assembly.

- 3 SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
